Booking details

There are 45 residential spaces, which cost £133. This can either be paid in full or in two instalments:

- a deposit of £50 payable when you book
- the balance of £83 to be paid by Sunday 10th March

If money alone would stop you from coming, there are bursaries available to help with the cost. Please contact Helen Stone in the church office for more details. (And if you are able to pay more to help with these bursaries she would love to hear from you.)
